

# Student Organization Adviser of the Year 2008-2009 Nomination Form

This award is given annually by the Division of Student Affairs to recognize an adviser who has demonstrated commitment to the students he/she advises, desires to spread the message of the group he/she oversees, and attempts to promote an atmosphere conducive to education and leadership development.

The winning adviser will have gone beyond the usual advising duties to help members of an organization accomplish their goals and improve the functioning of the organization as a whole. This award is meant to honor advisers who have taken a personal interest in the students they work with. The winning adviser will receive a \$100 award.

## Student Organization Adviser of the Year Award Criteria

1. The adviser must be nominated by a student organization that he/she advises.
2. The adviser must advise organizations recognized by ASB, USG, GAPSA, Division of Student Affairs or a university department.
3. The nominating organizations must be officially registered with Student Programs (<http://studentprograms.tulane.edu>).
4. The adviser must have advised the organization for at least one full semester.

Application deadline for this award is **5 p.m., Wed., March 18, 2009**. Information must be submitted by the deadline and should include responses to the questions and contact information on the next page.

Nomination forms must be returned to Student Programs in the Center for Student Involvement, LBC Garden Level by **5 p.m., Wed., March 18, 2009**. Nominated students may submit resumes to Student Programs by **5 p.m., Fri., March 20, 2009**. Awards will be presented at the Student Crest Awards ceremony Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at 6 p.m. in the Kendall-Cram Hall of the LBC.
