### **2008-2009 Application Form**

Named for the former Vice President for Student Affairs Martha Sullivan, this award is given annually by the Division of Student Affairs to recognize a student organization that has been a leader among the more than 200 recognized student organizations at Tulane University. The Student Organization of the Year award will be presented to the student organization which through its initiative, activities and projects, has been successful in accomplishing stated goals, serving the students it was designed to serve, and has had the most significant positive influence on Tulane and the surrounding community. The winning organization will receive a \$250 award.

#### **Student Organization of the Year Award Criteria**

1. The organization must be recognized by ASB, USG, GAPSA, Division of Student Affairs or a university department, with active status beginning no later than April 2008.
2. The organization must be officially registered with Student Programs (<http://studentprograms.tulane.edu>).
3. The organization must be free of disciplinary or probation sanctions for at least three years.

#### **Student Organization of the Year Award Selection**

Application deadline for this award is **5 p.m., Wed., March 18, 2009**. Information must be submitted by the deadline and should include responses to the questions and contact information on the next page.

Nomination forms must be returned to Student Programs in the Center for Student Involvement, LBC Garden Level by **5 p.m., Wed., March 18, 2009**. Nominated students may submit resumes to Student Programs by **5 p.m., Fri., March 20, 2009**. Awards will be presented at the Student Crest Awards ceremony Wednesday, April 22, 2009 at 6 p.m. in the Kendall-Cram Hall of the LBC.
